

INFORMATIONAL BULLETIN SEPTEMBER 2022

A. COVID-19: General Rules that apply in Greece at the moment

- For the time being – and as long as the epidemiological data remains at the same levels - in order to enter Greece, there is no need for the display of a vaccination certificate or a negative test.

- The obligatory use of mask is restricted to the public means of transport (buses, trains, etc.), pharmacies, medical centers and hospitals. It is highly recommended for people to use a mask in crowded indoor or outdoor places though.
- For the time being, there is no need for the display of a vaccination certificate or negative test result at any place in Greece.
- People that have been triple-vaccinated, will not be in quarantine at all if they come in contact with someone that is sick with covid-19. They **do need** to wear masks type N95 or KN95 or FFP2 though, for 10 days.
- For the time being, the quarantine period for people that have been **infected with covid-19** is as follows:
 - Quarantine for at least five (5) days and minimum or no contact with other people. The day of the positive test is considered day 0 and then we have the five (5) days of the quarantine.
 - After five (5) days of quarantine and if the person has no symptoms at all or if the symptoms have improved during this 5-day period and the person hasn't had any fever and hasn't used any antipyretic medication for at least 24 hours, the quarantine can cease. If the person still has fever, they need to remain in quarantine until complete absence of fever.

- Obligatory use of masks of high respiratory protection (N95 or KN95 or FFP2) for at least five (5) more days after the quarantine is over.
- For the time being, the quarantine period for people that have been **in contact with a covid-19 case** is as follows:
 - The use of mask of high respiratory protection ((N95 or KN95 or FFP2) for ten (10) days and a PCR or Rapid Antigen Test five (5) days after the exposure to the covid case. If someone lives or works with other people, they also need to have a test on the first day they came in contact with the covid-19 case as well.

Actions in case of a covid-19 case during the competition

- The athlete, official or delegate will be isolated in a separate room. The three daily meals of the isolated person will be sent to his/her room, using all the necessary safety procedures.
- Close contacts of the covid case will run a rapid test under the supervision of the OC medical coordinator and FISU Medical Delegate and will follow all the rules that apply in Greece for people in contact with covid-19 cases.

Financial Aspects

- Delegations shall pay the Organizing Committee 70€ per night for the concerned person if the stay is out of the event dates to finish the quarantine.
- The delegation is responsible for any flight changes and re-booking costs
